It will also deal with issues of diversity and multiculturalism in these societies. Dr. Tirelo Modie-Moroka has a special interest in health issues in social work and the situation of populations at risk such as low income groups, young delinquents, homeless women, cross-border migrants as well as persons with severe and persistent mental illnesses. Regarding social work methods in this particular context, the course will deal with group work, community practice, prevention methods, assessment, intervention, evaluation as well as methods in clinical social work practice.
