For a man I believe it is no problem even they have to distribute during the night, but for me it is a problem. But soon I will sign a contract with a deliverer that will distribute my works.

If my job continues successfully, I think that after a while I open a shop with my work.

I have enough time because I do these gifts and jewelry at home, even when I'm spending time with my family.
